***I want to share with you some useful information about building Resilience in Children from an article posted by Karen Young. (<http://heysigmund.com>).***

"Building small humans into healthy, thriving big ones isn't about clearing adversity out of their way. Of course, if we could scoop them up and lift them over the things that would cause them to stumble, that would be a wonderful thing, but it wouldn't necessarily be doing them any favours. A little bit of stress is life-giving and helps them to develop the skills they need to flourish. Strengthening them towards healthy living is about nurturing within them the strategies to deal with that adversity. Here is one way:

Build their executive functioning: This will help them manage their own behaviour and feelings, and increase their capacity to develop coping strategies. Some powerful ways to build their executive functioning are:

- Establish routines;
- Modelling healthy social behaviour;
- Creating and maintaining supportive reliable relationships around them;
- Providing opportunities for their own social connections;
- Creative play;
- Board games (turn taking), planning, working memory and mental flexibility;
- Games that involve memory
- Exercise;
- Giving them opportunities to think and act independently;
- Providing opportunities for them to make their own decisions."
