School sores: Please keep your child home if you suspect them of having school sores (for at least 48 hours) as these are highly contagious and can lead to more serious illness. Treatment, if not severe, is Chrystaderm cream, keep covered and complete hygienic standards to be observed – washing hands etc.

NB: The local nurse has informed us that refined sugar can feed this infection so a diet high in vegetables and "clean" food is a good idea.

Nits/Headlice: Once again these are doing the rounds. Please check your child/ren's hair regularly and treat if needed.

We will ring you to collect your child/ren if we feel that they need to be treated of either of the above afflictions.
