We will be discussing community response planning, emergency preparedness and what we can all expect if there is a Civil Defence emergency.

The more prepared a community is, the more likely it is that the community will be able to look after themselves and others and given the isolation of Curio Bay, Waikawa and Fortrose it is good for us to know that plans are in place for these communities.
